DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...People are pleased with all the new improvements to St. James Church and St. James School....

The new sound system, new sidewalks, new gutters, New steeples, painting of the church hall, new lights, And a defibrillator.

In the Spring the parking lot will be sealed. We have a new School sign and there were new gym projects. Why the "Newness" What are we doing? We are getting ready for some Big Celebrations in 2020!

- How best to celebrate the 150th Anniversary of St. James Church. On the weekend of September 5th and September 6th we will have 4 Masses recalling the 150th Anniversary of St. James Parish.
- 2. We would like to honor Fr. John Welch (60 years a priest) on September 19th at the 4:30 Mass.
- 3. We are hoping to celebrate the 150th Anniversary at the annual 200 Club Dinner. The date will be mid-October.
- 4. As regards the 125th Anniversary of the La Salette Missionaries at St. James we will celebrate 4 masses on October 31st and November 1 (ED. Note 25 years ago we did not formally celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the La Salettes in Danielson we will really celebrate it this year with 4 great Masses.
- All of these celebrations will lead us to the 150th Anniversary of St. James School (2024). Lots to celebrate and lots of prayers.

The La Salettes came to Danielson in 1895 and 5 years later in 1900 built our church (cost - \$24,000.) our new St. James School was blessed and dedicated on January 8th, 1956. The total price tag was (\$150,000.)

The priests, sisters and Parishioners were ambitious in 1900 and in 1955 – 1956 raising \$174,000. So in their spirit the Priests, Sisters, Deacon and Parishioners pledge a \$1,000,000. This is why we call a Daydream.

People ask how we can help. We always say "No Gifts" as regards all the Anniversaries. But the Planning Committee has big plans to raise \$250,000.each year for the next four years so we (the Friends of La Salette) can give the School a "cool million" for their 150th Anniversary in 2024. Why did we pick these dates? November 1st is one of our favorite Feast Days (All Saints), September 19th is the Feast of La Salettes.

Why September 5th for the Big Celebration?

Here is why: The first Baptism on record at St. James' Parish is the following: September 5, 1869.

On the fifth day of Sept. 1869, I baptized Francis, born on the 24th day of August, of John McGorty and Bridget Keegan.

The Sponsors: Michael Gavin and Maria Conely (signed) J.A. Princen.

The first marriage is thus recorded: September 21, 1869. On the twenty-first day of Sept. 1869, I united in matrimony Thomas Diette and Adelaide Jette according to the rite of Holy Mother Church.

The Witnesses: Hiber Gablieau and Rosalie Jette.

The interviewer (Dustin from Duke University) from the Lilly Foundation asked me how can you raise \$250,000 without a big campaign and have no phone calls and no letter writings and no pledges and no sponsors. We have a 3 point plan.

- 1. A bazaar-less bazaar will raise \$45,000.
- 2. The Year End Campaign will raise \$80,000.
- 3. The Friends of La Sallette will raise \$125,000.

Sounds like a plan.....Thank you.

Will this work??? We have been successful in the past. Last year we reached our Goal. And the Friends of La Salette in 2020 have already raised \$30,000.



THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

March 15, 2020

First Reading: Exodus 17:3-7

This story from Exodus reveals that the Israelites, after their escape from Egypt, cast all blame for their sufferings on Moses. In this instance, they were dying of thirst. When Moses appealed to the Lord, the Lord directed Moses to strike a rock and water would gush forth

Second Reading: Romans 5:1-2, 5-8

Paul reminds the Romans that because Christ died for all people, they are acceptable in God's sight.

Gospel: John 4:5-42

Jesus converses with the Samaritan woman at Jacob's Well. When Jesus indicates that whoever drinks from the water He gives will never be thirsty again, the woman immediately answers, "Give me this water, sir...". Jesus then reveals that she has had five husbands and tells her that He is the Messiah. The woman believes Jesus and proclaims this news to all the townspeople, who believe her and come to see Jesus.
