The pastors that span the troubled times of the Great Depression through the debilitating effects of World War II... so many hardships, so many joys...and countless stories of faith that rest in the stillness of the jewel-box cathedral. We are still here 1895-2019, 124 years of community and serving.

Who can forget St. James School and the Sisters of St. Joseph. The team of Florida, Lucille, Sr. Doris, Rene, Paul, Louis, Paul & Ernie, Sister Leslie, Diane, Bev, Susanne, Helen and Denise, Diane and Dolores (trustees), Jane & Kim, Deacon Rene, Paul Boire and Linda Joyal.

The school has its' own list of principals, teachers, volunteers, and wonderful Grads & Students. Always and forever, the anonymous generosity of faith-filled parishioners continue to be caring stewards of God's gifts to them.

Our Lady of La Salette born again in a land far from the fields of France where first she shared her faith with peasant children. Fr. B. Crane, Fr. F. Crane, Fr. Boo, Fr. Mac., Fr. Barry Fr. Ray, Fr. Scott, Brother Ron, Brother Bob and the Parish priest, Fr. Elson. We said good-bye on October 15th 2017.

The Pilgrim Pastors continued and continue the journey birthed a century ago...long in the time of fragile humanity and so short in the eye of eternity. The church buildings continue to change...new paint, new floors, new roofs...new landscaping...new paving...new organ...even air conditioning and a great Construction Firm.

A Vatican Council intervened to turn the interiors around...face to face...side by side...a Reconciliation Room replaces a confessional box...the Pilgrim people continue their

The La Salettes made a difference in Danielson, Brooklyn Hampton and Jewett City. The Friends of La Salette and the La Salette Community came together to build a school, a church, a rectory, a convent and a cemetery. Thank-you for having us.

This passage from the book of Exodus enjoins all to adhere to specific religious and social laws. It urges all to act with justice and compassion towards others.

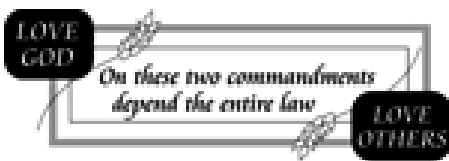
Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:5c-10

INCREASED CAPACITY AT ST. JAMES CHURCH

WILL BE 200 PEOPLE: According to the new Executive Order N. 9F by Governor Lamont; concerning limitations on religious gatherings - the increased capacity for worship gatherings will be limited to **no more than 50 percent of the building's capacity or a maximum of 200 people, whichever is lower provided that all persons present wear masks, and that a distance of 6 feet is maintained between all persons or groups not from the same household** in effect immediately until November 9, 2020. The Diocese of Norwich will follow the guidelines of the Governor until any changes or subsequent Executive Orders on this topic comes later on.
