DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR:

DAYDREAM REPEAT: On August 1st I was talking to some La Salettes. We talked about the 143rd anniversary of Our Lady of Lourdes. The La Salettes

were proud of the 54 vocations from the local parishes

at St. James, La Salette and Lourdes.

I mentioned two of the priests from our Diocese came from Our Lady of Lourdes. Fr. Bob and Fr. Frank. The La Salettes were impressed with the fact that three former Provincials served as Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes. Fr. Frank Crane, M.S., Fr. Bill Crane, M.S. and Fr. John O'Neill, M.S. I mentioned three of my former students were also named Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes. Fr. Tom Sickler, M.S., Fr. Gerry, and Fr. Dan Scott, M.S. Finally we told everyone two of our Superior Generals came from

St. James and Our Lady of Lourdes. Fr. Celestin Crozet, M.S.,

Pastor 1905-1912 and Fr. Gene Barrette, M.S.

Today I heard the Olympics are coming to the U.S.A. in 2028. Someone asked if I have any Olympic stories. In 1963 in Albany, N.Y. I coached two of our best runners from La Salette, Altamont, N.Y. in the Olympic Trials. Steve Rogowski and Dick Girard.

My second Olympic Story is the following; on Wednesday October 15, 1997 Fr. Brian and I flew from New York to Athens, Greece. The next day Fr. Brian and I ran the famous track where the first Olympics took place. How did I remember the date? Well on October 15, 1997 at 11:00AM I celebrated the funeral Mass for my mother, Anne. (age 94) at St. Peter's in Bridgeport. After the burial and reception at my brother Gene's home, my three sisters, Peggy, Ann and Mary and my brother, Gene told me at 6:00PM "we are driving you to New York to catch the plane" that will take 40 St. James parishioners to Greece and Turkey. On October 15th I am saying good-by and God bless to my mother and on October 16th I am running the Olympic track in Athens, Greece. That was 24 years ago. When you turn 86 you can have great memories; cherish your memories. That is what this Daydream Column tries to tell all of us today.

How about the future? The Diocese of Norwich and the La Salette Missionaries are planning their future. Neither the Diocese nor the La Salettes have anyone in the "bullpen". So I say to the Parishioners of St. James – I will stay as long as the Bishop and our Provincial keeps renewing my contract. The school and parish have never been better and we added a new Gym.

Fifty nine years ago I thought I would be long retired but we realize God has other plans for us.

Four years ago for my anniversary and birthday...they gave me a top-flight athletic field on Rte. 101.

This birthday (August 7th) will be the best gift ever. A 30th Anniversary as Pastor and next year, 60 years as a priest. With such an outpouring in generosity, who would ever want to leave!

The La Salette Missionaries asked me if we have spiritual plan for St. James Church and St. James School. We do have a plan. It is the same plan I learned at Sacred Heart School in Bridgeport, CT in the 1940's from the Sisters of Mercy. It is the same plan we taught at St. Basil's in Chicago in the early 1970's. It is the same lesson that Sister Theresa Joseph taught to the St. Joseph's School 6th graders in Quincy, MASS in 1962 (One of her students was Nora Joseph). First I will share the spiritual plan then I will share the number one story of Covid-19 with all of you. On my birthday (August 7th) Maggie Weaver told the same story in the weekly column in the Killingly Villager. Thanks to Maggie.

Our spiritual plan memories

- 1) Share your memories
- 2) Remember your heroes
- 3) Give thanks to those that encouraged you
- 4) Do kind deeds and do good deeds
- 5) Pray & bless and remember spiritual people

Back in 1962, Nora Joseph learned this lesson from her 6th grade teacher Sr. Theresa Joseph in Quincy, MASS. She prayed for a newly ordained priest – for 58 years then she wrote him a letter thanking him for becoming a priest:

"Dear Fr. O'Neill. I live in Los Angeles, but grew up in Quincy, MA where I attended St. Joseph School taught by the Sisters of St. Joseph. In 1962 I was praying for individual seminarians soon to be ordained. I can also recall attending his first Mass as an ordained priest. From time to time I would think about the seminarian I was given. Who was he? Where did he shepherd his flock? A while ago I was looking through my mother's missal. There was a holy card commemorating the first Mass of John Joseph O'Neill. I believe you may be my priest!

She found me celebrating a Virtual Mass from her home in Hollywood, California. When I received the letter I contacted Nora Joseph in Hollywood, California. She watches all our virtual mass. When I announced her story of prayer in our St. James No: 1 Covid-19 high lite, she could not believe it. We discovered that is her new mission thanking people that do good and are kind by sending letters and emails to them.

The 3rd part of the tri-angle is "whatever happened to Sr. Theresa Joseph"- our 6th grade teacher who encouraged her students to pray for vocations.

In the late 1960's she left teaching to organizing a program in Boston to help Teenagers and young ladies (ages 14-24). It is called the 'Bridge over Troubled Waters'. The program has helped young people for over 50 years.

On July 28th leaving St. James Church, Sr. Barbara Whalen called. She is now living in Cape Cod. Her name used to be Sr. Theresa Joseph. We had a wonderful conversation.

What did we have in common! Our mission is to do good deeds and to do kind deeds. That is what we both preach and teach. She told me she is in good health and both of us (at that time) are at the Age of 84. All three of us hope to get together after Covid -19. As I always say: Great stories happen at St. James. I am glad I have been in contact with two good women, Sr. Barbara Whalen and Nora Joseph. Stay tuned. Amen
