**DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...****A REFLECTION ON CHURCH FINANCES**

Whenever an official asks Fr. John O'Neill what is his #1 concern for the future of the St. James School and St. James Church, he gives the same answer most pastors give. It has to be money. In recent weeks, St. James Parish told the community how we raise the necessary funds for St. James School and St. James Church.

It takes many hands to accomplish what we have done. We failed to mention our two biggest collections or fund raisers. We all know the Friends of La Salette raises over \$120,000.00 every year. Most of the money is raised outside the parish. The other collection is the Year-End Collection. Some years we collected \$50,000.00, so far we have raised \$2,700.00.

Many of the parishes have a Letter Campaign or use the E-Mail system to solicit funds. Having a Fund Raising Firm is often costly. So, we simply use the Bulletin Daydream Column. We do mail some bulletins to some of our Benefactors. Does it work? The Friends of La Salette have raised almost \$600,000.00 in five years and the Year-End Collection has raised almost \$800,000.00 in 21 years.

This is the second year we have gone public.

We call these two collections the St. James miracle. (Year End and Friends of La Salette)

Our thought is to thank all of you.

**DAYDREAM II...REMEMBERING MY BIRTHDAY???**
