**DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...**

Best time to be a sports fan. Super Bowl Sunday, Basketball is big around here. We ask....Will Baseball Start on Time? We missed the basketball games at St. James last year. On Valentine’s Day we say “Be A Good Sport”.  
Congrats, to St. James Varsity Girls Soccer Champs!

**DAYDREAM II** ... Ash Wednesday and Valentine’s Day – is there a connection? We tell people we love them on this day. On Ash Wednesday. We tell God we love Him. Who would you like to receive a Valentine from? Pope Francis said he would like to hear from children. Children have written to Pope Francis asking him questions like, “What did God do before the world was created?” and “How come there are so few miracles now?” These letters and the Pope’s answers are in a new book!! **Letters to Pope Francis**. If you ask Fr. John O’Neill the same questions he would say he loves to receive Valentine cards and letters from the children of St. James. Fr. John O’Neill writes that down thru the years I’ve received 1000’s of letters. Here is a new sampling...

An 8<sup>th</sup> grader wrote – “I am so thankful that you use real life situations and your stories to help us understand the gospels. Our favorite stories are the referee’s missed calls and the man in the cab saying: ‘I am Henry I am going to a party’”.

The students love the First Friday Masses. Many thanked me for baptizing them at the School Mass. Others thanked me for being here and blessing them and then added “you are a good man”. Others said thank you for loving us.

Ash Wednesday and Valentine Day has the same message that the children wrote in their letters to the Pope and Fr. John O’Neill. We wonder if the Pope has his own song like **“Sweet Fr. John”**?

Thank you for loving us, for caring for us, for praying for us, for playing and swimming with us and thank you for telling the good stories at Mass. If you do this it will be a great Lent! Thanks to our Students for their kind words.

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Jeremiah 17:5-8

Jeremiah compares a man who seeks strength in flesh but abandons God to a bush in the desert, bereft of nourishment and unable to grow. Yet a man who trusts in God is like a tree beside a river, fed & strengthened by it even during times of drought.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:12, 16-20

Paul addresses those who believe in Christ's teachings, but are not convinced that he rose from the dead. He calls their faith worthless, because they have not been freed from their sins. Paul then emphatically declares that Jesus did rise up again, as will all those who truly believe in him.

Gospel: Luke 6:17, 20-26

Jesus tells his followers that those who are insulted in this life because of him will be rewarded richly in heaven. Yet those well received by all will despair in heaven, since people had often respected false prophets and mistreated true prophets. Those who hunger, perhaps for spiritual knowledge, shall be filled. Yet those who are full in this life will be hungry.

Official Approved Notice from U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Connecticut

**Sexual Abuse and General Claims in The Roman Catholic Diocese of Norwich, Connecticut Bankruptcy**

The Norwich Roman Catholic Diocesan Corporation, a/k/a the Roman Catholic Diocese of Norwich ("Diocese" or "Debtor") has filed bankruptcy in order to restructure its nonprofit organization. Please read this notice carefully as it may impact your rights against the Diocese and provides information about the case, *In re The Norwich Roman Catholic Diocesan Corporation* (Bankr. D. Conn.). This notice is a short summary.

**Who Should File a Sexual Abuse Claim?**

Anyone who was sexually abused, on or before July 15, 2021, and believes the Diocese may be responsible for the sexual abuse must file a claim. This includes sexual abuse in connection with any entity or activity associated with the Diocese. Sexual Abuse Claims include but are not limited to: sexual misconduct, touching, inappropriate contact, or sexual comments about a person or other behaviors that led to abuse, and regardless of whether you thought the behavior was sexual abuse or not.

**When Should I File a Sexual Abuse Claim?**

Regardless of how old you are today or when the sexual abuse occurred, you need to file your claim so that it is received by 5 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) on March 15, 2022.

If you do not file a timely Sexual Abuse Claim, you may lose rights against the Diocese and against Diocese Related Entities, including any right to compensation.

Your information will be kept private. For a list of names of clergy that have been identified in connection with sexual abuse claims, go to <https://www.norwichdiocese.org/Find/Accused-Clergy>. The Sexual Abuse Bar Date of March 15, 2022 is not subject to further extension, even if there is a change in the applicable statute of limitations. You should consider submitting a proof of claim even if you believe your claim may be subject to an affirmative defense such as a statute of limitations.

**When Should I File a General Bar Date Claim?**


If you have a non-sexual abuse claim, you will need to file so that it is received by 5 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) on March 15, 2022. More information is available at <https://dm.epiq11.com/case/rcdn>.

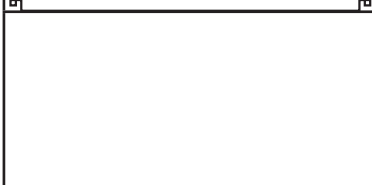
