

Dear Parishioners.

With profound sorrow, we announce the passing of Fr. John J. O'Neill, MS. He went home peacefully to the Lord on Tuesday, October 11, at 10 pm. He suffered a stroke.

Fr. John was born in Bridgeport, CT., and predeceased by his parents, Eugene J. O'Neill and Anne O'Neill, his brother Eugene P. O'Neill and his nephew, Eugene M. O'Neill. He is survived by his three sisters – Sr. Mary O'Neill, RSM, Sr. Ann O'Neill, RSM, Sr. Peggy O'Neill, RSM, and his sister-in-law Nell O'Neill, and his nephew Ken O'Neill.

Fr. John joined the La Salette community in 1949. A religious priest for 60 years (ordained on May 26, 1962). He was an inspiration and a blessing to many. He loved the St. James parish community and the students and teachers of the school and enjoyed his ministry in St. James for the last 31 years.

Fr. John found the joy of his religious life and priesthood in preaching the Gospel and helping

the people. He witnessed the La Salette identity and Charism in the places he served and lived a life of Reconciler. His love for the estranged Catholics and spirit of welcoming all were outstanding.

It is always difficult saying goodbye to someone we love and cherish. But we believe in the hope that he is in the hands of God. He is not alone; we are with him in prayer.

Let us remember the words of Our Lord "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God and faith in me... I shall come back to take you with me, that where I am, you also may be. You know the way that leads to where I go."

We pray for Fr. John that he may complete the journey to heaven. Say with faith, Fr. John, you belong to Christ...

#### TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME First Reading: Exodus 17:8-13

Amalek and his people attacked the Israelites, so Moses instructed Joshua to lead some of the Israelites into battle the next day. While Moses kept his hands raised in prayer, the Israelites were winning. But when he put his hands down, they would begin to lose. So two others helped him keep his hands raised, and Joshua and the Israelites won the battle.

#### Second Reading: 2 Timothy 3:14—4:2

Paul tells Timothy that the Scriptures are inspired by God and are an excellent tool in teaching others about God's expectations of his people. Knowledge of the Scriptures, coupled with faith in Jesus, will lead many people to salvation. Paul urges Timothy to continue preaching the gospel, although this will sometimes be a difficult task.

#### Gospel: Luke 18:1-8

Jesus speaks about a corrupt judge who lacked respect for either God or man. A widow repeatedly asked him to settle a case in her favor. He finally settled the case, only because he grew weary of listening to her requests. Jesus points out that if even this corrupt judge eventually listened, then God, who is just, will certainly answer the pleas of his people.
