## Daydreams of Pastor

On December 9, 1531, an Indian man named Juan Diego, now canonized had a vision of Mary, the mother of Jesus, at Tepeyac, a poor Mexican Indian village outside Mexico City. This apparition occasioned the conversion of nine million Indians to Christianity in twenty years. The Virgin of Guadalupe was declared the *Patroness of Latin America* by Pope St. Pius X in 1907. After the Second World War, Pope Pius XII looked at the suffering, fragmented world and declared Our Lady of Guadalupe *patroness of the Americas*.

Saint John Paul II, in 1979 was the first pope to visit the shrine in Mexico City and described the Guadalupe event as “the beginning of evangelization” with a vitality that surpassed all expectations. The pope called her ‘*Mother of America and Star of Evangelization*’.

I still remember the visit to Guadalupe last year. My guide and translator, shared the great story of the apparition. The apparition tells us how Jesus, as Emmanuel, and Mary his mother, want to be among us, especially among the poor, the downtrodden and the marginalized in society who have neither voice nor political or social influence. That is why Our Lady appeared to a poor Indian in a village, speaking his native language, and why Mary did not appear to any of the Spanish overlords. God wanted the Basilica in honor of Jesus’ mother built in the village, not in the city.

The vision challenges us to listen to the ordinary people who do not look or act like important people and to treat them with reverence. While it is true that God loves each and every one of us, there is a special place in God’s heart for the poor and the powerless – God’s preferential option for the poor. Take the challenge to see and serve Jesus in the poor and the broken-hearted in our communities as we continue preparing and come closer to the birth of Jesus...

## FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT

### First Reading: Isaiah 7:10-14

Ahaz receives from Isaiah a prophecy that he will be successful in war and is urged to ask for a sign that the prophecy is true. The sign is “The virgin shall be with child and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel.”

### Second Reading: Romans 1:1-7

Paul greets the Romans by pointing out that Jesus is the Christ who was promised to them in Scripture. He, Paul, is the apostle favored with the task of spreading the name of Christ to all.

### Gospel: Matthew 1:18-24

In a brief, straightforward, simple narrative, Matthew recounts the events leading to Jesus’ birth. He details the appearance of the angel in a dream to Joseph and stresses that “All this happened to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophets.”
