PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Palm Sunday combines contrasting moments, one of glory, the other of suffering: the royal welcome of Jesus in Jerusalem and the drama of the trial, culminating in crucifixion, death and burial.

With the celebration of Palm Sunday every year we stop to remember and relive the events which brought about our redemption and salvation. What we commemorate and relive during this week is not just Jesus' dying and rising, but our own dying and rising in him, which will result in our healing, reconciliation, and redemption.

What is Holy Week? Holy Week is Passing Over. In the Passion narrative we will hear Jesus telling us. just like I passed over from death to life; from cross to resurrection; from Good Friday to Easter Sunday, you have to pass over. So, you put to death your selfishness, envy, jealousy, lies, sins and pass over to love, mercy, compassion, goodness and forgiveness.

At the very beginning of this Holy Week we see Jesus being mocked, tortured, hurt, ridiculed, beaten and killed. We notice his fear in the garden of his agony, and also his willingness to go to the end for what he believes in and sees as his mission in life. We see him on the cross, when he seems to feel neglected by his Father.

What else do we see in the Passion of Jesus? We see the shame and humiliation he endured. Anyone can face similar humiliation and shame but what makes the humiliation of Jesus luminous in the dark is the immense love with which he responded to his tormentors. No one has ever loved more than Jesus. No one can ever love us as much as Jesus has loved us. This week is Holy not because of the shame and humiliation that Jesus endured. This week is Holy because God filled this week with infinite love. Only love can sanctify.

Though we pray and desire for this kind of love, we all struggle to earn it and share it. Learn from Jesus - His generosity is marvelous. Life offers a lot of pain, suffering, hopelessness, misunderstandings, tragedy and so on.... This week, we can bring those wounds to Jesus, and fervently pray for the grace to trust and love. Holiness is a fruit of our endurance and love.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD

First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7

In a tone of quiet sadness, Isaiah describes the buffets and insults given to the Suffering Servant. The

passage ends on a note of hope.

Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

In exultant tones, Paul tells the Philippians to rejoice because Christ became man, died on the cross, rose from the dead, and sits triumphantly at the right hand of the Father.

Gospel: Matthew 26:14-27:66

This is the solemn narrative of the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Matthew recounts the treachery and betrayal of Judas and then describes the events of the Last Supper. culminating in the institution of the Eucharist. Jesus endures the Agony in the Garden; he is then brought before Caiaphas and Pilate and condemned to death. After His resurrection, the centurions shouted, "Clearly this was the Son of God!"
