#### DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us – that the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." The blessed Eucharist is contained within the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself. "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking."

It was a blessed experience for our children from the CCD and School to receive the Eucharist for the first time. We had 21 communicants upon receiving the guidance from their teachers, prepared themselves for this great event in their life. They prepared themselves through prayers and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and were all excited to receive the Lord and make him part of their lives.

The Holy Eucharist is so important, since it is a reinstating/recalling of the sacrifice Jesus made on the cross. When we receive the body and blood of Christ we become sons and daughters of Jesus Christ. The one who created the Universe and gave life to the things in the universe comes to us in a piece of bread. The one who changed water into wine, the one who transformed the wine into his own blood comes to us as life. This is what makes Eucharist the heart and strength of all Christians....

In the Gospel of John: 6: 51 we read; "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world." What a beautiful way to explain Eucharist and to bring Eucharist into our hearts.

I take this opportunity to congratulate the children on their reception of First Holy Communion and their teachers and parents for their continued support. We have the responsibility to become models to our children..... By our life - explain to them what it means by Eucharist. Help them to keep the light burning in their hearts.

#### THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

#### First Reading: Acts 2:14, 22-33

After the Holy Spirit descends upon the apostles, Peter preaches with great enthusiasm to both Jews and Christians. He recalls for them in vivid terms the miracles and wonders that Jesus performed.

#### Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:17-21

Peter makes reference to the Passover, when the Jews escaped from Egypt because the blood of the paschal lamb was shed. Now they are being saved from sin by the blood of Christ, the Lamb of the New Testament.

#### Gospel: Luke 24:13-35

Jesus reveals Himself to two disciples on the way to Emmaus. After explaining to them the passages in Scripture which referred to Him, Christ "took bread, broke it, and distributed it to them." Then they recognized Christ and their "hearts burned within them.


