# DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

#### "Feast of St. Joseph, the worker"

St. Joseph has two feast days on the liturgical calendar. The first is March 19—Joseph, the Husband of Mary. The second is May 1—Joseph, the Worker.

We celebrated the year 2021 as the "The Year of Saint Joseph". The year that helped us to reflect more on St. Joseph, the just man, the dreamer, and the silent saint who was the custodian and protector of Jesus and Mary, always doing the will of God.

A just man is one who faithfully does his duties to God, to lawful authorities and to his fellow human beings. Joseph did his duties to God faithfully by obeying God's laws and his duties to others. Joseph, the dreamer receiving answers to his fervent prayers as dreams. Joseph raised his heart and mind to God in all his needs and dangerous situations in life. And as a silent saint, Joseph always did the will of God and protected and provided for Jesus and Mary.

Pope John Paul II once said, "Saint Joseph is a man of great spirit. He is great in faith, not because he speaks his own words, but above all because he listens to the words of the Living God. He listens in silence. And his heart ceaselessly perseveres in the readiness to accept the Truth contained in the word of the Living God."

We know that he was the chaste husband of Mary, the foster father of Jesus, a carpenter and a man who was not wealthy. We can see from his actions in scripture that Joseph was a compassionate man, and obedient to the will of God.

St. Joseph is the patron of the universal Church, and of fathers, the dying and social justice. Celebrating the feast of St. Joseph, should help us to make a promise to lead saintly lives by becoming faithful in little things, as St. Joseph was and fulfill our commitments. FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

#### First Reading: Acts 2:14a, 36-41

With great authority, Peter proclaims to the people that the Christ who was crucified is indeed the Messiah. Urging them to reform and be baptized in the name of Christ, three thousand responded to his words and were baptized.

#### Second Reading: 1 Peter 2:20b-25

This is a strong exhortation from Peter to the people to endure suffering for Christ as he did for them. Healed by his wounds, they have "returned to the shepherd."

#### Gospel: John 10:1-10

Christ uses the beautiful image of the shepherd to describe his care for his sheep. He also says he is the sheepgate and promises that "Whoever enters through me will be safe."
