DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

The Feast of the Ascension for the year 2023 is celebrated on Thursday, May 18th. The day commemorates Jesus Christ's ascension into heaven.

With his return to the Father, Jesus completes his mission on earth. But just before his Ascension, Jesus entrusted to the disciples the mission of preaching the Good News and evangelizing the whole world by bearing witness to him through their lives. It is in his Ascension that we see Jesus entering fully into the life and glory of God.

Why do we climb mountains? Because - Mountains are symbols of 'aboveness' and offer us a lovely metaphor for raising our gaze to higher things.

The Feast of Ascension, invites us to make the shift from seeing Jesus as Man to seeing Jesus as Lord – to move from Jesus to Christ. Christ is the cosmic Jesus, Lord of all creation, present since the foundation of the world. Only such a Christ can dare to use superlatives: all authority; go to all the nations; all the commands; I am with you always. Such a cosmic universality lifts our minds to realities we may never have dreamed of before. He is with us at all times and in all places, releasing a new energy upon the earth, the energy of the Holy Spirit

The Ascension of Christ happens 40 days after the Resurrection, showing us where we are headed. Having been redeemed from slavery to sin, we are now to enter the final promise: a definitive share in the glorious life of the Triune God, into which Christ, as the firstborn, has ascended, carrying humanity with him, as a promise and hope for us.

We can confidently bring our doubts, our confusion, and our struggles to the feet of Christ who knows our hearts. He is here, he is gently teaching us his plan, and he is faithful in his promises. Let us learn to trust him more deeply.

May God enlighten the eyes of our mind to see how infinitely great is the power that he has exercised for us believers...


