DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

One of the last two precious gifts given to us by Jesus is the Holy Eucharist as our spiritual food, and the other is Jesus' mother Mary as our spiritual mother.

Corpus Christi reminds us of the abiding presence of our loving God as *Emmanuel*, in order that we may give collective thanks to our Lord for his living with us in the Eucharist. The feast also gives us an occasion to learn more about the importance and value of the "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Eucharist, so that we may appreciate the Sacrament better.

Corpus Christi – is a three-in-one feast: feast of the Eucharistic sacrifice, of the sacrament of the Eucharist and of the Real Presence of Christ. This Corpus Christi is a mystery, a scandalizing one for the unbelieving, but a core experience of faith for the believer.

The Holy Eucharist is a covenant. A covenant is different from a contract. In a contract there is equality. You pay and you get worth your payment. In a covenant, however, there is no equality. The giver has everything to give and nothing to receive. A covenant is not based on equality but on gratuity born of the goodness and generosity of the giver. Jesus makes with us a new covenant – It is a covenant of love. Signed in his blood shed for us and for many for the forgiveness of sins.

In the Holy Eucharist we have everything to receive. Jesus fills us and shapes us for mission and ministry—for life and faith. Jesus says, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven." Bread is one of most basic of foods—it has been for centuries. But more than that, he is our LIVING bread. We hear Jesus say that whoever eats his flesh and drinks his blood remains in him and he in us. Yet, do we understand what it truly means to remain in him?

To remain in Jesus as true as we remain in our commitment - is to accept his challenge: not just to receive him, but also to see the world through his eyes, to engage the world with his passion, and to feed the world with his generosity.

He tells them, in mysterious and beautiful words, that the bread he gives is his flesh and says, "I myself am the living bread... If anyone eats this bread, he shall live forever."


