DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Golden Jubilee of Priestly Ordination Fr. Tom Sickler, M.S.

Jubilee is a time to thank God for all the blessings received. It is a time to celebrate with gratitude and joy at the wonderful ways the Lord has guided us. To be grateful is to recognize the love of God in everything He has given us. And today we thank God with Fr. Tom for what he has been in spreading the message of reconciliation and serving the people of God.

Fr. John O'Neill always talked about the forthcoming Golden Jubilee of Fr. Tom at our kitchen table. And we were all waiting for that day. I am sure Fr. John will be happy that we are here celebrating the Jubilee, with much happiness. When I invited Fr. Tom to come to St. James to celebrate his jubilee, I could see the joy of his heart in his happy face. He said it all in one short sentence: "I would love to". I believe that says it all; the love he has for St. James.

50 years ago on June 16, 1973 Fr. Tom Sickler was ordained a Priest at St. Joseph Church in Fitchburg, Mass. The priestly ministry he began in St. Joseph parish, Fitchburg was extended to the parishes in Nashua, NH, Hartford, CT, Jewett City, CT Westfield, MA and Danielson, CT. He also served as pastor of St. Joseph Church in Fitchburg, MA and of Our Lady of La Salette Church in Brooklyn, CT.

The first time I met Fr. Tom was in 2004, while I was doing the mission appeal. At one of my visits to Danielson, Fr. John took me to Fitchburg, where Fr. Tom was the Pastor. I remember the day quite well spending time in the rectory and having our meal together.

In his letter to the Romans St. Paul writes; "Christ's gift of himself brought grace and life". Fr. Tom followed these words as a La Salette religious missionary priest and brought grace and life to the people whom he served.

This is a special day. No one but you Fr. Tom can say what this day means to you. I am sure that you are delighted. Your family, community, friends and the parishioners of St. James are praying with you to offer a special "thanks" to God for the blessings of the past 50 years.
