#### DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR... Wisdom & Encouragement

Short summary of Pope Francis's message to the Committee preparing for the forthcoming National Eucharistic Congress in the United States of America.

The Pope spoke about the need for Eucharistic Revival, and shared his hope for the future of the Church in the United States. He says *the Congress* will be an occasion for the faithful to "commit themselves with ever greater zeal to being missionary disciples of the Lord Jesus in the world." This connection between the Eucharist and mission cannot be ignored. The Holy Father reminded us that "the love we celebrate in this sacrament cannot be kept to ourselves but demands to be shared with all. This is the sense of a missionary spirit."

He encourages us to continue our efforts to contribute to a revival of faith in, and love for, the Holy Eucharist, the "source and summit of the Christian life". The Eucharist is God's response to the deepest hunger of the human heart, the hunger for authentic life, for in the Eucharist Christ himself is truly in our midst, to nourish, console and sustain us on our journey.

It is more than a symbol; it is the real and loving presence of the Lord. It is his hope, that the Eucharistic Congress will inspire Catholics throughout the country to discover anew the sense of wonder and awe at the Lord's great gift of himself and to spend time with him in the celebration of the Holy Mass and in personal prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. We must rediscover the sense of adoration in silence, the form of prayer that we have lost.

In the Eucharist, we encounter the One who gave everything for us, who sacrificed himself in order to give us life, who loved us to the end. We become credible witnesses to the joy and transforming beauty of the Gospel. It impels us to a strong and committed love of neighbor. For we cannot truly understand or live the meaning of the Eucharist if our hearts are closed to our brothers and sisters.

The pope went on to say, "Two groups of people come to mind whom we must always seek out: the elderly, who are the wisdom of a people, and the sick, who are the image of the suffering Jesus."

Just as the rain and snow water the earth and make it fruitful, so does the word of God bring forth good seed.

# Second Reading: Romans 8:18-23

Reminding all that the trials and sufferings of this life are "as nothing," Paul says that the glory we shall receive will overshadow all things.

### Gospel: Matthew 13:1-23

Jesus tells the parable of the sower and the seed. The seed that landed on the footpath, on rocky ground, or among thorns withered and died; the seed that fell on good ground -- "the man who hears the message and takes it in" ... "bears a yield of a hundred-fold."
