DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Dear Parishioners,

This is a great occasion for us to celebrate the feast of St. James, our patron and our eagerly awaited parish picnic that brings together the entire parish community for a day of joyous fellowship. The picnic serves as a delightful celebration of togetherness and shared values. We gather to enjoy a variety of activities and delicious food. It fosters a sense of belonging and strengthens the bonds among the members of our parish community.

The importance of the parish picnic extends beyond its festive atmosphere. It plays an essential role in building a closely-knit community, where people of all ages come together to forge lasting connections. I would like to see our parish building up that understanding, enhancing social life and the spirit of unity and compassion in our parish.

Our parish has a long history of 153 years of its existence. It is good to know a little bit of the history of our parish. The first resident priest (Rev. Michael McCabe) arrived in Danielson in 1850 and offered the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for the first time in Danielson at a private residence. The new priest who was assigned built a church and the rectory in Moosup and his successor took up the residency in there, which made Danielson a mission of Moosup.

Rev. James A. Princen took up the residence in Danielson and on the first day of September1869 St. James parish was re-established (in the official records of the diocese 1870). La Salette Missionaries from France took over St. James Parish on December 08 in 1895. Rev. Clovis M. Socquet, M.S the first La Salette to be assigned as pastor of St. James. Rev. C.P. Bedard and Rev. Pierre Roux, M.S assisting in the parish as curates.

In 1900, fifty years after the arrival of the first resident priest in Danielson; the new completely organized parish of St. James, with its new church was in place.

Wishing you all a very happy feast of St. James! May he intercede for us all!

First Reading: 1 Kings 3:5, 7-12


