DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Faith is great!

The Gospel passage for this weekend speaks about us having strong faith. It comes down to never giving up for someone you love. Never losing faith. God's mercy and love are available to all who call out to Him in Faith.

Reading the gospel, I thought it is good to share the strong faith of the Canaanite woman, a mother who never gave up. The mother went to Jesus and implored his help. Not once. Not twice. But three times. She wouldn't take no for an answer. Finally, Jesus was so moved by her faith that he couldn't refuse her. And her daughter was healed.

We can only imagine what the mother was going through. The helplessness, and the worry. But this mother had something more powerful. She had faith – faith in someone who was not even a part of her race or religion and He became her last, best hope. This is an inspiration and a lesson for us who sometimes lack faith. Those who may seem to be outside our circle aren't necessarily outside the circle of God. His circle is limitless. And there is always room for more.

What a comfort! All of us, at one time or another, have been "outside the circle." All of us have felt like foreigners: marginalized or isolated – emotionally, spiritually, and physically; uncomfortable, like we don't belong. Like love, faith asks that we surrender ourselves to something we can never fully understand. And it asks us to persevere. If we do that, the result may surprise us. We may find ourselves walking where we've never walked before. We may see life renewed, and hope restored.

Faith requires that we keep walking, even when the wind and waves are against us. Faith demands that we keep pleading, even when God seems to turn away. Faith asks us to wrap our arms around those we love, even when they don't remember who we are.

TWENTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 56:1, 6-7

The Lord wants all people to love and honor his name. He says that those who honor him by obeying all of his laws will be "made joyful in my house of prayer."

Second Reading: Romans 11:13-15, 29-32

Paul describes his hopes that his fellow Jews will follow the example of the Gentiles he has been preaching to. He claims that just as God has mercy for their disobedience, he wishes to show mercy to the Jews as well.

Gospel: Matthew 15:21-28

A Canaanite woman begged Jesus to help her daughter, who was being plagued by a demon. Jesus at first refused her and said that "My mission is only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." The woman was so persistent that Jesus said she had great faith and then he healed her daughter.
