DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

This week on September 14th, we celebrate the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The feast is celebrated for two reasons: (1) to understand the history of the discovery and recovery of the True Cross and (2) to appreciate better the importance of the symbol and reality of Christ's sacrificial love.

The origins of this feast can be traced back to the 4th century when Saint Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine, is said to have discovered the True Cross during a pilgrimage to Jerusalem. The finding of the cross is a symbol of hope, redemption, and victory over death, resonating deeply with us, believers. The Exaltation of the Holy Cross serves as a reminder of the sacrificial love of Christ and his triumph over sin and death through his crucifixion and resurrection.

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross holds a special place in our hearts as it captures the core message of Christianity – the transformative power of selfless love and the ultimate triumph of light over darkness. It serves as a reminder of the lengths to which God's love goes to redeem humanity and offers a chance for us to draw strength, inspiration, and spiritual renewal from the symbol of the cross.

The memorial feast of our lady of sorrows on September 15th reminds the spiritual martyrdom of Mary, Mother of God, and her compassion with the sufferings of her Divine Son, Jesus. The feast invites us to reflect on the suffering of Mary, as she stood at the foot of the cross. The feast commemorates Mary's deep sorrow and unwavering faith amidst the pain of witnessing her beloved son's crucifixion, emphasizing her role as the compassionate and sorrowful mother of all humanity.

The feast also invites us to focus on the seven sorrows, that Mary endured throughout her life, which include events such as the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the child Jesus in the temple, and Jesus' crucifixion, among others. The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows provides an opportunity for us to seek solace and find inspiration in Mary's example of enduring suffering with grace and trust in God's divine plan.
