DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

FEAST OF OUR LADY OF LA SALETTE



We not only welcome but live this annual celebration of the *Feast of our Lady of La Salette*, as a very special gift for our St. James family. La Salette is not new to Danielson. The ministry of La Salette religious in Danielson started in the year 1895. The Blessed Mother's invitation to come closer and

receive her Son's compassion, care and love became part of this St. James family.

On September 19, 1846, Mary stood in for her Son Jesus and spoke to Maximin and Melanie, two shepherd children, interceding for them and for us all. The Queen of Heaven came to us in all simplicity, not to impose her authority but to serve her people by drawing them to be their best Christian selves and become once again a people of faith and fidelity.

What is unique about this apparition is her tears. She cried while she spoke for her son. The children who beheld the Virgin Mary, seated on the stone of the mountain, saw her weeping in profound sorrow, astounded with the bitterest grief and shedding abundant tears. "She cried all the time she spoke to us," the children said.

There was something remarkable about her tears. The tears of the Blessed Virgin did not fall on the ground. They fell upon the crucifix which she carried on her breast, and then they vanished. The tears of Our Lady of La Salette – what a touching and admirable subject of meditation for Mary's people, her children. Nothing in the world is more capable of touching our hearts than tears, because they are the language of afflicted and suffering souls, and this mysterious language is always understood and appreciated. But if tears always have the gift to soften us, they are especially eloquent falling from the eyes of a mother.

The tears asked of us by the Holy Virgin are the tears of the converted heart. O Virgin of La Salette, open our hearts to repentance that we may weep with you over our sins. Your tears will not be lost; they will convert our hearts and turn us back to your Son. As we pray the 9th day of novena to our Lady of La Salette and ask for her maternal care and protection, let us be close to her and to her Son, Jesus.

Our Lady of La Salette, Reconciler of Sinners, pray without ceasing for us who have recourse to You.
