DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

I am happy to present to you our operating report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

I strongly believe that the most important thing that keeps us united is our prayer, Eucharist, Monthly Holy Hour and the many other liturgies. The spiritual growth is very important and your participation and dedication are really commendable. We had many Baptisms, First Penance, first Holy Communion, Confirmation and Marriages. And let us continue to pray that there may be an increase of faith in our parish and school community.

Everyone wonders how St. James Parish and School managed its combined annual budget of \$1,700,000. How does St. James Church and School do it? It does through the contributions of many, many people and the long working hours to meet our financial responsibilities.

St. James Church raised around \$470,000 this year. Our weekly collections were \$366,000 and the church fundraising was \$104,000. From the \$470,000 we were able to give \$281,000 as subsidy to the school. Most of this money is for tuition assistance based on need. There are so many people and groups to thank and it was a team effort that made it possible. We also gave \$33,000 to the A.C.A. (Annual Catholic Appeal). And we recently gave a check to our diocese for \$18,806.

The School fundraisers made \$43,000. The Friends of La Salette, The Pourings and Passages and The Endowment Fund has been very generous to St. James School.

I would like to thank everyone for your generous contributions to the parish and the school. I love the spirit of generosity in all of you and your sacrifice and dedication for the well-being of St. James. It will always be rewarded.

Looking at the combined budget for 2023 - 24 (\$1,900,000) I believe we should do more. We have greater responsibility this year to contribute more and to work harder. But I trust, I trust in you dear parishioners and the St. James school families.

Continue with your generous support to St. James. Let us make it happen together.

First Reading: Isaiah 45:1, 4-6


Cyrus, King of Persia and friend to the Jewish people, becomes the Lord's anointed one, and through God's intervention, returns the Jews to their own country.
