FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

"The time is fulfilled. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent. Believe in the Gospel."

The primary purpose of Lent is to prepare us for the celebration of Jesus' death and Resurrection. The Church tries to achieve this goal by leading her children through "repentance," fasting, prayer, almsgiving, and self-control.

Whole people of Noah's time were immersed in evil, and God saw that Noah alone was righteous before Him in that generation. God cleansed the earth of the wicked generation that did not obey and honor Him. Even though the people faced the flood of God's anger, the 'remnant of the flood' experienced the flooding of God's mercy. When Noah stepped out of the Ark, God gave him a reassuring promise, and made a covenant of steadfast love with all humanity. And God remained ever faithful to his word.

Mark's Gospel gives no details about the tempting of Jesus in the desert, but we know them through Mathew and Luke; there we find that Jesus holds fast to the importance of worshiping God alone. Jesus who was tempted in the desert shows us the way for us in our times. He identified with us as he endured temptations and he knows how to give us the help we need to resist the tempter. Unlike Noah's time those who were persuaded into sin, Jesus resisted the temptation to disobey God's word and to turn off God's voice. There is always the temptation to forget who God is and who we are. This does not mean we are unimportant. On the contrary, God tells us, "I, the Lord, am your God, ... you are precious in my eyes." (Isaiah 43:3-4)

Lent invites us to deepen our relationship with our God. To seek the One who is the fountain of all delights and everlasting joy. To seek to delight in him away from the temptations and distractions. How do we do this during this Lent?

1.Listen to God in the Bible: If you can, try to set aside some time every day to spend with his word that is a way to stay away from temptations. 2. Cultivate a sense of gratitude in prayer: Thank him for his blessings every day. 3. Listen and respond to others' needs: Yes, listen with your eyes and with your heart open.

Take these little spiritual challenges right in front of us, and conquer our temptations as Jesus did, by prayer and penance. Hence, during this Lent, let us confront our evil tendencies by talking to God and by listening to Him speaking to us.

First Reading: Genesis 9:8-15

God made a promise to Noah that he would never again devastate the entire planet with a flood. He also told Noah that the symbol of this promise would be a rainbow in the clouds.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 3:18-22

This letter from Peter reminds all people that Christ died for us so that we might be led to God. We have been saved by our baptism; not a physical cleansing, but a promise to continually strive to obey God.

Gospel: Mark 1:12-15

Mark briefly tells of Jesus' stay in the desert, where he was tested by Satan. He did not give in to temptation, but reappeared in Galilee to proclaim the good news.
