## DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

"God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life."

God had compassion on his people, but they ianored his kindness and suffered the consequences. Even then, he did not abandon them altogether, he brought them back to their homeland. John says that God showed his love for the world by sending Jesus, so that we might have eternal life; this fits together perfectly with Paul's words about the richness of God's mercy and the free gift of salvation. As St. Paul says, even when we were dead in our transgressions, God still had great love for us.

"God loves each one of us as though we are the only one to be loved" (St. Augustine). He pours his infinite love into our littleness; his infinite power into our weakness; his infinite wisdom into our foolishness; his infinite holiness into our sinfulness. Saint or sinner God loves us. "It is when we deserve love least that God loves us most!" Our spiritual life will change not when we know how much we love God but when we experience how much He loves us.

When we accept God's love, we experience eternal life. When we refuse God's love, we are sadly passing sentence on ourselves like the person who shuts the windows and draws the curtains preferring to remain in darkness when the sun is shining brightly outside.

God asks only that we love him back accordingly. This is a form of submission at a deeper level to grace. Think of the scene of the Annunciation, where Mary, full of grace, says: "Behold the handmaid of the Lord, be it done to me according to your word." The desire to do God's will makes it easy to submit to it.

God has poured out his grace upon us. We joyfully draw near to him of all good gifts in the spiritual practices we take up in this season. Let us allow God who is madly in love with us, touch and transform our lives during this holy season of lent.

## FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

## First Reading: 2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23

The people of Judah practiced many abominations, even polluting God's temple in Jerusalem. They mocked the messengers he sent among them, until he grew so angry he delivered them to the King of the Chaldeans. Those who weren't killed were exiled and became servants for seventy years. Cyrus, King of Persia, was ordered to build a temple to God in Jerusalem, and he freed the servants as God had inspired him to do.

## Second Reading: Ephesians 2:4-10

Paul declares that God brought us to life in Jesus, though we had been dead from our sins. He reminds us that it was not a reward for our good service so no one should take credit. Instead, we must remember that it was not our doing, but a sign of God's mercy and love for us.

## Gospel: John 3:14-21

God so loved the world, he sent us his only Son so that all who believed would have eternal life in him. The light came into the world, but those who were wicked avoided it, for fear that their evil deeds would be exposed. But those who believed were unafraid of the light, where it would be clear that their deeds were done in God.
