

#### FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

#### DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

"Unless the grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit."

Jesus is the seed that will die so others might have life, the grain of wheat that will be crushed and made into bread that feeds us. We see his life emptied on the cross. We see his life broken and shared on the altar.

This is the last week of lent. Lent is about a change of heart and let us get ready to enter Holy Week. Where do we go to have our stony hearts turned once more into hearts of flesh? We go to Jesus, who lifts us up so the Father can write on our hearts not with ink, but with the blood of the Son.

Lent is a time to seek Jesus. Today's Gospel opens with a scene where some Greeks came to worship in the temple seeking Jesus by approaching Jesus' disciples, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." They were already in the Temple and still searching for an encounter with God! This is what the Gospel tells us today. The sacred we seek is not in stones, nor in the beauty of the building and land. The sacred we seek is in the heart of every person. That is why when we allow the sacred to shine forth in us, everything we touch, everything we do, and everything we plan becomes sacred because of us.

The sacredness of the heart of each person makes our community sacred. It can happen only by our willingness to fall on our knees with humility and goodwill to serve others, to share what we have, and to allow our roots to go deeper into our relationships. Just as Jesus became the "Promised Messiah of Glory" and the "Conquering Son of Man" by offering his life for others, we, too, if we would come to Heaven, must die to self by loving obedience, spending our lives in self-giving, sacrificial service.

Jesus challenges us to choose the Lord first, and the Father will honor whoever serves him. Choosing the path of surrender in service to him glorifies God and allows us to produce much fruit, including care for our own families.

Let us seek the Lord everywhere, let us be aware of the sacredness in our hearts and in our neighbors. Touch them with love because we have been touched by God's love and mercy.

#### FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

#### First Reading: Jeremiah 31:31-34

The Lord comforted his people, who were exiled to Babylon, by telling them of the new covenant he planned to make with them. The Lord declared he would write his law upon their hearts, and that he would forgive their evil and forget the sins they had committed in the past.

#### Second Reading: Hebrews 5:7-9

Though God could have heeded his Son's prayers and spared him suffering, Jesus accepted his Fathers will. Through his suffering, he learned obedience and became the source of eternal salvation for all people.

#### Gospel: John 12:20-33

Jesus was afraid of the suffering he knew he must face. Yet he explained just as a grain of wheat must die to be harvested, he had to face his hour of suffering to glorify his Father's name. Jesus explained that once he was lifted from earth, he could draw all people to himself, lifting them to eternal life.
