#### THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

#### DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

St. Peter takes a conciliatory approach in addressing those who crucified Jesus: "You acted out of ignorance." And he offers them the prospect of having their sins wiped away. St. John writes something similar to his Christian community. He takes for granted that they will commit sin, and assures them that they have an advocate, Jesus, who will not only plead their cause but is himself 'expiation' for their sins.

Neither Peter nor John is remotely suggesting that it is all right to sin. Sin can have tremendous power over us. Peter and John were realists. They understood human nature and recognized that sin is a fact of life. They also realized that sin should not lead to despair. Peter knew this from personal experience. He denied Jesus. Afterward he proclaimed him to any who would listen.

Ignorance and doubt are also a fact of life. In Luke's gospel, Jesus has trouble convincing the disciples that it really is he standing there, and finally he proves it by eating baked fish. At the same time he, too, points to the gift of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

When our Blessed Mother appeared at La Salette, she was painfully aware of the reality of sin. Her list of offences is not exhaustive, but enough to indicate the nature of the sins that cause her the deepest concern. But there is no need to despair since there is a turning point in her message: 'a call for conversion'.

The promise that we receive this week is based on the Passion and Resurrection of Christ. That is why Jesus draws attention to his hands and feet, rather that his face, to verify his identity. I think that is why Mary at La Salette wears a large crucifix. He who conquered death can surely conquer sin.

Thanks to Peter and John and Luke that we are reminded this week of another fact of life, which we call hope.

#### THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

#### First Reading: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Peter reminds the people that they allowed Jesus to be killed, and preferred to allow a murderer to be released. But God raised him from the dead as had been prophesied. Therefore, all people should believe and turn to God, that their sins might be forgiven.

#### Second Reading: 1 John 2:1-5a

Jesus was offered up for the sins of the world. The only way to prove true faith in him, is to honor his commandments. Anyone who claims to believe, yet does not keep his word, does not truly believe.

#### Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

Jesus appeared to two disciples, though at first they feared he was a ghost. Jesus ate with them to prove he was not a ghost. He explained that he had fulfilled the prophets words about him. He also explained that in his name they must preach doing penance for the forgiveness of sins.




