#### **DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...**

Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us – that the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life." The blessed Eucharist is contained within the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself. "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking."

It was a blessed experience for our children from the CCD and School to receive the Eucharist for the first time. We had 21 communicants upon receiving the guidance from their teachers; prepared themselves for this great event in their life. The significance of the Holy Eucharist, the meaning of Holy Communion and the importance of living a life of faith were the prime motives of their preparation. They also prepared themselves through prayers and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and were all excited to receive the Lord and make him part of their lives. By receiving the sacrament, our children made an important step in their spiritual journey and it will surely serve as a foundation in their lifelong journey of faith.

The Holy Eucharist is so important, since it is a reinstating/recalling of the sacrifice Jesus made on the cross. When we receive the body and blood of Christ we become sons and daughters of Jesus Christ. The one who created the Universe and gave life to the things in the universe comes to us in a piece of bread. The one who changed water into wine, the one who transformed the wine into his own blood comes to us as life. This is what makes Eucharist the heart and strength of all Christians....

In the Gospel of John: 6: 51 we read; "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever. This bread is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world." What a beautiful way to explain Eucharist and to bring Eucharist into our hearts.

I take this opportunity to congratulate the children on their reception of First Holy Communion and their teachers and parents for their continued support. We have the responsibility to become models to our children. By our life - explain to them what it means by Eucharist. Help them to keep the light burning in their hearts.


