# DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...



The celebration of our birthdays is always a moment of great joy. We have a reason to be happy. celebrate, to and to exchange good wishes because today is the birthday of Holy Mother Church. Pentecost is the

celebration of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. It marks the beginning of the new covenant, and the birth of the public life of the Church.

Jesus simply appears amid the apostles and Blessed Virgin Mary. They could see him, they could hear him, and they could even touch him. He could simply walk through locked doors. He breathes on and into the disciples the Spirit and the Spirit empowers them. We are familiar with the power of his breathing from the creation story. Here today on this feast of Pentecost the same Jesus breathes the same divine breath. He is breathing in us all, to become the living tabernacles of his presence to the world and the continuation of his mission.

The Holy Spirit transformed the disciples in the most remarkable way. Before Pentecost they were a collection of confused disciples but after Pentecost they were totally changed. The fire of the spirit somehow changed the lives of those disciples. They were filled with the spirit that radiated from them and swept across the world like a tidal wave.

The Holy Spirit transformed the disciples into the body of Christ and the Church was born. The frightened apostles were transformed into preachers and evangelizers and were given the gift of tongues by a special anointing of the Holy Spirit. The listeners experienced a fresh anointing of the Holy Spirit through the apostles' gift of tongues. The early Christians became powerful witnesses and brave martyrs for their Faith in Jesus.

The Spirit breathed into them the mind of Christ. They received a whole new understanding and became a new creation in Christ. The Holy Spirit wants the same kind of transformation-this time, not in the disciples, but in you and me.

# PENTECOST SUNDAY

#### First Reading: Acts 2:1-11

During the Feast of Pentecost, tongues of fire came to rest on the heads of the disciples and they were filled with the Holy Spirit. Each disciple began speaking in a different language, and were understood by people from many different regions who were amazed at what they had witnessed.

#### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13

Paul explains that we are all members of one body. We have all been baptized in one Spirit and although numerous, we are one through Christ.

#### Gospel: John 20:19-23

John describes Jesus' first visit to the disciples after his resurrection. He gave them the Holy Spirit and the power to forgive other people or hold them responsible for their actions.
