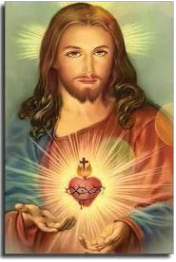

DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus



We celebrated the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, the 07th of June. It was a time to know more about the love of Christ for all mankind. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is one of the most widely practiced and well-known devotions, taking Jesus' physical heart as the representation of his divine love for humanity. This devotion is predominantly used in the Catholic Church. The devotion especially emphasizes the unmitigated love, compassion, and long-suffering of the heart of Christ towards humanity.

The heart is the deep center of our affective life. We are exhorted to have the mind of Jesus and urged to imitate his will. The Church does not have a feast in honor of the mind and will but of the heart of Jesus. The events and parables in the gospel describe his heart. His first miracle at Cana is bringing joy. He weeps at the tomb of his friend Lazarus. He feels the hunger of the multitudes. The parables of the lost coin, the lost sheep, and the lost son, depict the heart of Jesus.

The Sacred Heart is often depicted in Christian art as a flaming heart shining with divine light, pierced by the lance-wound, encircled by the crown of thorns, surmounted by a cross and bleeding. The heart and the flame stand for Jesus' unconditional love for humanity which he has expressed through his passion and death on the cross. The feast invites us to make sure that we do not stray from the flock of Jesus and thus to stop wounding his heart.

According to Pope Benedict XVI, in the heart of the redeemer we adore: God's love for humanity, his will for universal salvation and his infinite mercy. "This heart is not concerned with self-preservation but with self-surrender. It saves the world by opening itself. It saves by giving itself away. Thus, in the Heart of Jesus, the center of Christianity is set before us. It expresses everything, all that is genuinely new. This Heart calls to our heart. It invites us to discover the fullness of love which alone is eternity."

To make the feast an experience in our lives we, as a parish community, will have a special Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Sunday, the 9th of June from 11.45 a.m. to 4 p.m. Let us receive the source of new life and love everyone and pray for an increase of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Genesis 3:9-15

God asked Adam why he ate the fruit from the forbidden tree. Adam blames his companion, who in turn blames a serpent. God then told the serpent it would be banned from other animals, and be an enemy of humanity.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 4:13—5:1

Paul describes our belief that "He who raised up the Lord Jesus will raise us up along with Jesus." Although our bodies grow weaker, each day our inner strength grows. Paul also describes our burdens as light when compared to the eternal rewards we can attain.

Gospel: Mark 3:20-35

Some of the scribes felt that Jesus was possessed and claimed that he expelled demons with help from Satan. Jesus silenced them by asking, "How can Satan expel Satan?" Jesus also warned them that although many sins would be forgiven, blasphemy against the Holy Spirit would not. Jesus was then told that his mother, brother and sisters were asking for him. He asked, "Who are my mother and brother and sisters? Whoever does the will of God is brother and sister and mother to me." This demonstrates Jesus' deep love for all those who love God.
