DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

St. John the Baptist: The only Saint in the Church's calendar that has two celebrations: his birth which we celebrate this week on the 24th of June and his martyrdom on 29th of August.

John the Baptist is a unique and revered figure in Christianity. He is recognized as the forerunner of Christ, tasked with preparing the way for Jesus' ministry. His birth was foretold by the angel Gabriel to his father, Zechariah, who was initially struck mute for doubting the angel's message. This miraculous announcement emphasizes John's divine mission and his role in God's salvific plan.

He was chosen, consecrated and commissioned by God to precede Jesus and prepare the way for the coming of the Savior. Chosen by God before he was born from his mother's womb, he welcomed Jesus as he leapt with joy in the womb of Elizabeth. He preached and proclaimed repentance, calling the people of his time to conversion. The words of John the Baptist echo in our ears: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand! Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight."

Liturgically, the feast of St. John's Nativity invites us to reflect on themes of preparation, repentance, and the transformative power of God's promises. John's life and mission call us to turn away from sin and open our hearts to the redeeming grace of Christ.

The celebration of the feast should also serve as a reminder of the vital role we play in God's plan and the importance of faithfulness and humility in our spiritual life. Remember what John tells his disciples: "He must increase, but I must decrease", indicating the coming of the greater light, Jesus Christ.

Free and fearless, John pointed to Jesus and said to his disciples: "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". John should be an inspiration to us. Through honoring St. John the Baptist's birth, let us learn the significance of bearing witness to the truth and preparing the way for Christ in the world.




