FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR.... "My Lord and My God"



On July 3rd we celebrated the feast of St. Thomas, the Apostle to India. The feast of St. Thomas is one of the most important feasts among the Catholics in India. His wonderful profession of faith, "My Lord and My God" is the clearest declaration of Jesus' divinity in the Holy Scriptures.

St. Thomas, often known as "Doubting Thomas," but he was equally courageous, willing to stand by Jesus in dangerous times. He relentlessly sought the truth. Like an innocent child, he constantly asked questions. He wanted to believe for himself since faith for Thomas was so personal. We could be people brought up in a Catholic home, receiving good example from our parents and grandparents and been given a sound Catholic education. But faith is personal. No one can believe for me. One of the reasons why we sense a crisis of faith today is because faith has not been personalized and interiorized. Indeed, only such faith grows and matures.

Thomas traveled to India, where he established a Christian community, known as the Saint Thomas Christians. Thomas' Faith culminated in his selfsurrender to Jesus, his heroic mission to India in A.D. 52, his fearless preaching, and the powerful testimony given by his martyrdom in A.D. 72. His presence is "the cornerstone" of Christians and their Faith in India.

Thomas' tomb has become a significant pilgrimage site for Christians, and it stands as a testament to his enduring legacy and the early roots of Christianity in India. His journey to India represents the spread of Christianity beyond the Roman Empire and highlights the diverse ways in which the message of Jesus was received and adapted by different cultures. His story serves as a reminder of the transformative power of faith and the importance of missionary work in the history of Christianity.

Faith culminating in self-surrender to God leads us to the service of our fellow-human beings. Living Faith enables us to see the risen Lord in everyone and gives us the willingness to render each one loving service. The call for us today is to grow in the living and dynamic faith of St. Thomas. It becomes possible by knowing and experiencing Jesus personally, by strengthening our Faith by the power of the Holy Spirit and by sharing in the Divine Life of Jesus in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.

FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Ezekiel 2:2-5

Ezekiel is moved to respond to the call of God and to accentuate his teaching with a direct reference to the Word of God.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 12:7-10

Paul had questioned the value of his suffering, and God replied, "My grace is enough for you, for strength is made perfect in weakness." Paul then realized that although he was weak against persecution, he was strong in faith.

Gospel: Mark 6:1-6a

Jesus could do little for those in his own part of the country, for their lack of faith in him was so great. Therefore, he spent much of his time teaching in neighboring villages instead.
