#### **DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...**



The 10<sup>th</sup> National Eucharistic Congress will take place in Indianapolis from July 17 to 21, 2024. A time for us to worship the Eucharistic Lord and share Christ's love with

the world. We started this Revival in 2022 and this will continue till 2025.

The congress will highlight the diverse expressions of Catholic faith from different cultures and communities, bringing them together in a shared experience of worship and devotion. The congress will also serve as a reminder of the universal nature of the Catholic Church.

Last year Pope Francis spoke about the need for Eucharistic Revival, and shared his hope for the future of the Church in the United States and said, "The congress will be an occasion for the faithful to commit themselves with ever greater zeal to being missionary disciples of the Lord Jesus in the world." This connection between the Eucharist and mission cannot be ignored. The Holy Father reminded us that "the love we celebrate in this sacrament cannot be kept to ourselves but demands to be shared with all".

He encouraged us to continue our efforts to contribute to a revival of faith in, and love for the Holy Eucharist, the "source and summit of the Christian life". The Eucharist is God's response to the deepest hunger of the human heart, the hunger for authentic life, for in the Eucharist Christ himself is truly in our midst, to nourish, console and sustain us on our journey. Through the Eucharist, God desires to heal, renew and unify the Church and the world.

In the Eucharist, we encounter the One who gave everything for us, who sacrificed himself in order to give us life and who loved us to the end. Through the Eucharist, God walks into our hearts, and everything changes!

Let us in a special way pray for the success of the Eucharistic Congress. Let this communion rekindle a sense of devotion and commitment among us, encouraging us to rediscover the Eucharist as the heart of our faith. Let this be a milestone moment in the life of the Church and in all those who attend this great event.

Paul exults God's immeasurable generosity as he recounts all the blessings that have been bestowed upon all God's people. We all became adopted children of God when we heard the message of truth Christ brought to us, and because of it, believed in him.

#### Gospel: Mark 6:7-13

Jesus gave the twelve disciples authority over unclean spirits and sent them out to preach and heal the sick. He advised them to bring nothing with them and to shake the dust from their feet of any town where they had not been welcomed. Jesus wanted them to understand what they would need to do in his place after his death.


