DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

The presentation of Jesus in the temple mirrors our invitation to Christ into the temple of our hearts. Just as the temple was illuminated by His presence, we too can experience His divine light guiding us on our journey of faith and redemption.

The feast of the Lord’s Presentation reminds us of our consecration to God. Mary and Joseph took Jesus to fulfill their obligation of consecrating him to God with their offering. By offering Jesus in the Temple, they conveyed to the world that Jesus belonged to God. Mary and Joseph’s act of presenting Jesus reflects our need to offer our lives to God. Just as they dedicated Jesus in the temple, we should dedicate ourselves to His purpose.

The presentation of Jesus in the Temple became a day of reckoning for all those who were in the Temple. Simeon, who lived a life close to God, was able to recognize Jesus. He recognized Jesus as the Lord’s Anointed One. Simeon’s patient path reminds us to trust God’s promises, even when waiting seems long. Like Simeon, we can find fulfillment when God’s timing aligns with our hopes. His words reveal Jesus as the light for all, not just a chosen few. He prophesied that Jesus was meant to be the glory of Israel and a Light of revelation to the Gentiles. The presentation emphasizes that Christ’s salvation is inclusive and reaches every corner of the world.

Our consecration in Baptism is the fundamental dimension of Christian life through which we accept and proclaim that we belong to God. Our daily life must witness to this belongingness to God. Like Anna’s proclamation reminds us to share our encounters with Christ, we should eagerly spread the joy of our faith impacting those around us. Like Mary and Joseph’s role teaches us the sanctity of parenting, we are entrusted with guiding the younger generation in their spiritual growth.

We are God’s Temple. Jesus must be present, and be presented in this temple for all to see.

THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

First Reading: Malachi 3: 1-4

The prophet Malachi speaks to us about God sending a messenger “to prepare the way” and that God will suddenly come and appear at the temple. Malachi continues by telling us the offerings of Judah and Jerusalem will be pleasing to God.

Second Reading: Hebrews 2: 14-18

Jesus became like us. He shared fully in our humanity. By his death he freed us from the fear of death. Because Jesus was tested by suffering, he is able to help those who are also tempted.

Gospel: Luke 2: 22-40

According to the law of Moses, Joseph and Mary brought Jesus to the temple to be consecrated. They offered a sacrifice according to the law, “a pair of turtle doves or two young pigeons.” Simeon, a holy and righteous man, took the child into his arms and praised God. Simeon then spoke to Mary. He told Mary that Jesus “is destined to be the downfall and the rise of many in Israel.” Anna, a prophet of great age, praised God and spoke of the child who came for the redemption of Jerusalem.
