DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

Jesus speaks of bringing fire to the earth. This fire symbolizes the transformative power of His message, which may bring division. Jesus acknowledges that following Him may bring about division even within families.

Our faith journey involves endurance for the ultimate prize of eternal life. We have to endure struggles and hardships with perseverance. All that matters is to fix our eyes on Jesus, the source and perfector of our faith. When we face challenges and potential divisions, we have to draw stength form the examples of saints to persevere in our commitment to Christ. Discipleship comes with a cost, requiring us to prioritize our commitment to God above all else.

The history of the church is full of stories of martyrdom that accompanied those who chose Christ over worldly values and relationships. Yet, in the midst of all this, there is an undefinable, indescribable, unearthly peace that reigned in the hearts of those holy souls. Christ offers such peace which can survive violence and death; not the passing empty worldly peace that crumbles at the first instance of stress.

The image of Jesus crucified is the most powerful symbol of God's love for us. But Jesus himself recognized that many would reject him, and that faith in him would lead to division. The disruption, division, and revolution, which Jesus and his true followers cause in society by the fire of sacrificial love and the fire of justice, are necessary to re-set what's fractured, put right what's dislocated and cleanse what's infected.

At La Salette when our Blessed Mother appeared with the crucified Christ close to her heart, she riminded us that we seem no longer to care about the suffering and indignity he endured for our sake. She continues to remind us that the fire Jesus brings is the fire of love and the fire of hope!

On the day of our Baptism, we received the light of Christ and were instructed to keep that torch burning brightly until the return of Christ Jesus. In addition, the Holy Spirit was sent into our hearts at Confirmation to help set us on fire. Let us have the same fire in our hearts and courageously live out our religious convictions and principles.


