#### DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

September is so special to all those who love our Blessed Mother. In the first half of September, we usually celebrate three feasts of our Blessed Mother. Her birthday is on the 8<sup>th</sup> of September, her Most Holy name on the 12<sup>th</sup>, and her Sorrows on the 15<sup>th</sup>. We also prepare ourselves for the Feast of our Lady of La Salette with 9 days of Novena. The special novena from the 13<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup> will help us to seek her intercession in our day-to-day lives.

It is always a joyful moment to celebrate a birthday. Most especially when it comes to the celebration of our Heavenly Mother. It is the birthday of an ordinary woman who was chosen, and freely consented, to become the mother of an extraordinary Divine Child. The feast of the Most Holy name of Mary is celebrated four days after her birthday is celebrated. It honors Mary, Mother of God, as blessed and encourages us all to pray for her intercession to deepen our love of Christ and our relationship with the Lord.

The memorial feast of our lady of sorrows reminds us of the spiritual martyrdom of Mary, Mother of God, and her compassion with the sufferings of her Divine Son, Jesus. The feast invites us to reflect on the suffering of Mary, as she stood at the foot of the cross. The feast commemorates Mary's deep sorrow and unwavering faith amidst the pain of witnessing her beloved son's crucifixion, emphasizing her role as the compassionate and sorrowful mother of all humanity. The feast provides an opportunity for us to find inspiration in Mary's example of enduring suffering with grace and trust in God's divine plan.

The Apparition of our Blessed Mother at La Salette on September 19, 1846, was a call to conversion. It is so inspirational for all those who desire the conversion of their hearts. Mary invites us as she invited Maximin and Melanie saying, "Come near, my children, be not afraid; I am here to tell you great news." The invitation she gave us was to uplift us to a life of conversion. She asked us to submit ourselves to her Son, Jesus and not to forget the suffering she has taken to comfort us.

I pray that this 9 days of novena to our Lady of La Salette helps us to be close to our Blessed Mother and through her to her Son, Jesus. At the close of the nine days of novena, on the 21st we will gather as St. James family and celebrate the feast with a light lunch in the church hall after the 11 am mass.

Jesus went to share a meal with one of the leading Pharisees when he noticed other guests competing for places of honor at the table. He warned that a guest who takes the place of honor may be asked to move to the lowest place. Yet a guest who takes the lowest place is honored when a better position is offered by their host. He then added, "He who humbles himself will be exalted."

#### "La Salette Laity"

On September 19, 1846, Mary at La Salette reminded us of our Christian duties. She deeply lamented the lack of enthusiasm for the gospel that was so prevalent among her people. And invited us to conversion through prayer, penance and zeal.

In the Jubilee year 2000, Pope John Paul II acknowledged the significance of the apparition in promoting faith and devotion and emphasized the call to conversion and reconciliation as central messages. He supported the relevance of La Salette messages in our spiritual life by highlighting the importance of prayer and encouraged the faithful to reflect on the social and moral issues raised by the vision. And finally, he recognized Mary as a mediator and intercessor in the messages of La Salette.

Dear parishioners and friends, you have been very close to La Salette missionaries for the past 130 years since our arrival at St. James. The La Salette missionaries from France started our ministries at Danielson in 1895; 25 years after the establishment of St. James Parish.

La Salette missionaries all over the world have priests, brothers, sisters and La Salette Laity/Associates ministering to the spiritual needs of the faithful. Wherever the missions are established, the missionaries always had a support team called La Salette laity or associates working with them. Years ago, Fr. John O'Neill, M.S. established a group called "Friends of La Salette" at St. James. The group was very dedicated and supported our ministries. But all other La Salette parishes had a group called La Salette Laity. To unify with the formal name used in North America, starting this September the group will be called "La Salette Laity".

I know that some of you are not familiar with the La Salette missionaries. But I believe everyone in the parish and school should know about the missionaries who dedicated their lives for this St. James Parish and School and their missions all over the world.

Starting this October, we are establishing the La Salette Laity in our parish. The plan is to have classes on the La Salette apparition, history, foundation, message and spirituality every month till next September in 2026. The goal is to form the members and establish a dedicated group of La Salette Laity who are close to our blessed mother and supports the La Salette missionaries and their missions through prayer.


