#### **DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...**



Today, September 14<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The feast is celebrated for two reasons: (1) to understand the history of the discovery and

recovery of the True Cross and (2) to appreciate better the importance of the symbol and reality of Christ's sacrificial love.

The origins of this feast can be traced back to the 4th century when Saint Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine, is said to have discovered the True Cross during a pilgrimage to Jerusalem. The finding of the cross is a symbol of hope, redemption, and victory over death, resonating deeply within us.

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross serves as a reminder of the sacrificial love of Christ and his triumph over sin and death through his crucifixion and resurrection. This feast highlights the paradoxical nature of the cross - an instrument of suffering transformed into a symbol of triumph and redemption.

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross holds a special place in our hearts as it captures the core message of Christianity – the transformative power of selfless love and the ultimate triumph of light over darkness. It serves as a reminder of the lengths to which God's love goes to redeem humanity and offers a chance for us to draw strength, inspiration, and spiritual renewal from the symbol of the cross.

Jesus in the Gospel, refers to Himself being lifted up, mirroring the image of the bronze serpent. This lifting up, the crucifixion, becomes the means of salvation, inviting all to look to Him for eternal life. The Gospel underlines God's universal love, expressed through the gift of His Son. The cross becomes a sign of that limitless love, calling us to embrace the cross in our lives and to love one another selflessly.

Let us embrace the cross in our lives, finding hope and redemption in the sacrificial love of Christ and challenge us to find meaning in our own crosses. May the cross be a constant reminder of God's boundless love.

#### First Reading: Numbers 21:4b-9

The Jews were complaining against God and Moses of the tiring journey through the desert. The Lord punished them for such complaints with the bite of deadly serpents. After hearing the prayers of Moses for his people, the Lord instructed Moses to cure those who became ill with a bronze serpent mounted to a pole for them to see.

#### Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

In this letter to the Philippians, Paul tells us how Jesus set aside his form of equality to God and took on a humble, human form - obedient even unto death. God the Father greatly exalted Jesus because of this.

#### Gospel Reading: John 3:13-17

As today's first reading tells us of Moses raising the bronze serpent in the desert for those to be cured, Jesus says, too, that the Son of Man should be lifted up for all to see so the world might be saved and he who believes in him might enjoy eternal life.

#### THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

#### "La Salette Laity"

On September 19, 1846, Mary at La Salette reminded us of our Christian duties. She deeply lamented the lack of enthusiasm for the gospel that was so prevalent among her people. And invited us to conversion through prayer, penance and zeal.

In the Jubilee year 2000, Pope John Paul II acknowledged the significance of the apparition in promoting faith and devotion and emphasized the call to conversion and reconciliation as central messages. He supported the relevance of La Salette messages in our spiritual life by highlighting the importance of prayer and encouraged the faithful to reflect on the social and moral issues raised by the vision. And finally, he recognized Mary as a mediator and intercessor in the messages of La Salette.

Dear parishioners and friends, you have been very close to La Salette missionaries for the past 130 years since our arrival at St. James. The La Salette missionaries from France started our ministries at Danielson in 1895; 25 years after the establishment of St. James Parish.

La Salette missionaries all over the world have priests, brothers, sisters and La Salette Laity/Associates ministering to the spiritual needs of the faithful. Wherever the missions are established, the missionaries always had a support team called La Salette laity or associates working with them. Years ago, Fr. John O'Neill, M.S. established a group called "Friends of La Salette" at St. James. The group was very dedicated and supported our ministries. But all other La Salette parishes had a group called La Salette Laity. To unify with the formal name used in North America, starting this September the group will be called "La Salette Laity".

I know that some of you are not familiar with the La Salette missionaries. But I believe everyone in the parish and school should know about the missionaries who dedicated their lives for this St. James Parish and School and their missions all over the world.

Starting this October, we are establishing the La Salette Laity in our parish. The plan is to have classes on the La Salette apparition, history, foundation, message and spirituality every month till next September in 2026. The goal is to form the members and establish a dedicated group of La Salette Laity who are close to our blessed mother and supports the La Salette missionaries and their missions through prayer.


