DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...



"Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe"

Today we are presented with an apparent paradox – a king on a cross. Christ's kingship is revealed in

self-sacrifice and humility. His crucifixion is the ultimate expression of love and redemption for all humanity. Despite the mockery Christ endured on the cross, He responded with mercy and compassion. Even in His suffering, He welcomed the repentant thief into paradise, exemplifying the boundless mercy of our King.

We need to set our excitement within the framework of what Jesus replied when Pilate asked him if he was a King: He implied that he was a King but added that his Kingdom was not of this world. Truly Jesus' kingship is not of this world. It is our greatest privilege to serve such a King as Jesus.

What is your understanding of a King? A King is someone who has power, money, fancy cars, a lot of servants, land and who dresses in expensive clothes. To show their authority they sit on a throne. I believe we know the difference. And with no doubt we can say Jesus is a King who is Kind, loving, serving, humble and forgiving.

"To which king should I be loyal" - is not a question many of us face in modern times, but for both faithful Jews and followers of Jesus, it was a decision on which their lives could literally depend. We realize how relevant the question remains when we ask, "Who or what reigns in my life?" The answer determines both our present and future joy.

Christ the King invites us to participate in His kingdom, characterized by mercy, forgiveness, and sacrificial love. As we honor Christ as the King, let us acknowledge His reign in our hearts and lives. His kingship challenges us to align our values, actions, and priorities with the kingdom of love and justice.

We have a king who has a heart. We have a king who understands. He cares for us even when he is hung on the cross. He forgives the one who says "sorry" for his or her mistakes. Let us continue to pray; "Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven".

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

First Reading: 2 Samuel 5:1-3

Samuel describes how all the tribes of Israel went to David in Hebron and said they were his bone and his flesh and it was he who led them back to Israel. The Lord told David he would be a shepherd to His people. David made an agreement with the elders and was anointed king.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:12-20

Paul explains to the Colossians that God has made them fit to share in the inheritance of the holy ones in light and that through the Son we have redemption and forgiveness of sin. He describes Jesus as the image of the invisible God, the head of the church and in Him all things hold together.

Gospel: Luke 23:35-43

Jesus is mocked by the crowd as he hung on the cross. Above him was an inscription that read "This is the king of the Jews." One of the men being crucified with Jesus tells Him to save them and Himself, while the other asks that he be remembered when Jesus is in his kingdom. Jesus said in reply, "Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise."


