## **Immaculate Conception**

The unheard-of news that the angel Gabriel brought to young Mary evoked several reactions in her. Mary was

troubled at heart; she wondered what was in store for her. She had honest doubts. In probability, she would not have fully grasped the explanation given. Yet, at the end of it all, she trusted. She surrendered. She bared her soul before God and said, "so let it be."

One may argue that the grace of the Immaculate Conception enabled her to respond the way she did. But are we very different? The grace given to Mary at the conception was given to us at our baptism. The same grace can empower us to say 'amen' to God's will.

Prayer is a dialogue. God speaks; we listen. We speak; and God listens. Prayer begins and ends with God for he alone must have the first and the last word. God speaks to Mary proposing his plan to her, assuring her not to be afraid. That is the assurance we get at prayer. We must not be afraid because nothing is impossible to God. Mary remains open to God's will. This is what prayer must do: make us ready to do his will even when his will remains mysterious. What a wonderful illustration of prayer we see in the encounter between angel Gabriel and Mary!

Just like any mother who wants her children to inherit or acquire all her good qualities, our Immaculate and holy Heavenly Mother wants us to be holy and pure children.

The Immaculate Conception reminds us of how Mary was chosen from the very beginning of her existence to be the mother of Jesus. We are also reminded that we are all chosen by God before we are born, and God knows us, and has a plan for us. His plan for us is to be holy and immaculate like Mary. We become holy by living differently from the world that does not recognize God and his Word. We become immaculate when we are able to love without even a trace of egoism. In such a blameless love, God is reflected through us. It is a challenge. Let us resolve to do our best to be the kind of person, that God knows and wants us, to be.

## First Reading: Isaiah 11:1-10

In this beautiful passage, a messianic prophecy, Isaiah exults in the coming of the Lord, who will bring justice and peace for all.

## Second Reading: Romans 15:4-9

Paul reveals to us the necessity of living in peace and harmony. His words "Accept one another, then, as Christ accepted you, for the Glory of God" are as needed today as they were in Paul's own time.

## Gospel: Matthew 3:1-12

John the Baptizer prepares the way for Jesus. Clothed in a garment of camel's hair, he baptizes the people in the Jordan River, but warns the Pharisees in ringing tones that they must give evidence that they mean to reform.


