### DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...

John the Baptist was born with a special mission: to prepare the way of the Messiah. Although John was not familiar with Jesus as the Messiah yet, the Holy Spirit worked through him, he was then able to recognize Jesus and to testify, Jesus is the Son of God. He proclaims: "There is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world".

The Gospel passage presents three themes today, namely, the witness John the Baptist bears to Jesus, the revelation and identification of Jesus as the "Lamb of God," and the call to discipleship.

We may choose to accept John's testimony in today's Gospel as a personal and corporate call from God to us to become witnesses to the Lamb of God. The Gospel reminds us that being a disciple of Jesus means that we grow by Faith to become witnesses for Him. And bearing witness to Christ is an active, lifetime enterprise. One cannot be a disciple of Jesus at a distance.

This is one great lesson from John the Baptist: When we do our mission, we always know where we stand. We work in the vineyard to give glory to God, not to get attention for ourselves. Like John, we need to recognize the presence of Jesus in our midst. We can only do this through the grace and guidance of the Holy Spirit.

We have to live and die like the Lamb of God. How can we live like the Lamb of God? It's by leading pure, innocent, humble, selfless lives obeying the Christ's commandment of love; It's by appreciating the loving providence and protecting care of the Good Shepherd in His Church; And It's by receiving the Body and Blood of Christ and deriving spiritual strength from the Holy Spirit through the Sacraments.

How can we die like the Lamb of God? By sharing our blessings of health, wealth and talents with others. By bearing witness to Christ in our illness, pain and suffering. And by offering our sufferings for the salvation of souls and as reparation for our sins.

Today, make a promise - that we may become witness to the Lamb of God.
