DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR



The year 2025 was another good year for St. James. The great celebration of the feast of St. James and the Parish Picnic was a great time for us as a parish family to come together and share our joys. The presence of the travelling Relic of St. Andre Bessette at St. James was a time for everyone to venerate the saint, pray through his intercession and to learn about his life and ministry.

The nine days of Novena concluding with the feast of Our Lady of La Salette and the parish day celebration was another memorable event. The 150th anniversary of our school and the first visit of our newly ordained bishop, Bishop Richard Reidy will ever be remembered. The weeklong celebration was concluded with the Eucharistic celebration and reception. The program was organized very well by our parish council and the school staff, students and parents. Thank you all for being part of this historical event.

The parish mission was a great success, which helped our family to stay together and prepare for the great feast of Easter. I cannot forget the talks of Fr. William Kaliyadan, M.S., (Provincial Superior of La Salette Missionaries, North America) and his great reflections and personal stories. Another highlight of the year was the St. Joseph's Family event, in which the parents and children enjoyed the time with prayer, socializing and activities for the families and the Mother's Day celebration for all the mothers/ladies to get together to pray, exchange rosaries and share their joy as one family.

The veneration of Saints' relics on All Saints Day (November 01) was a great experience for many. It was also an opportunity to reflect on the dedicated life of the saints and to pray for their intercession. The feast of '*Corpus Christi*' with a day of adoration, the feast of the Sacred Heart, the celebration of Divine Mercy, crowning of the blessed mother, and fifth Sunday rosaries were some other spiritual renewal programs we had in the year.

We also had the blessing of the pets organized by Knights of Columbus and other social events like the Italian dinner, pancake breakfast, breakfast with Santa and many others. I thank the Parish council, Finance council, Vocation committee, and K of C for all the time they have spent preparing for all these events.

The pilgrimage/bus trip to the National Shrine of our Lady of La Salette in the '*Year of Hope*' with 45 people and seeing the Christmas lights was loved by the group. I am sure their experience of seeing over a million lights and the Crèche Museum will stay with them forever.

The establishment of La Salette Laity and the monthly classes for the group keep our spiritual life strengthened and our devotion to our blessed mother.

We celebrated the 1st Holy Communion of our 25 children from the School and Religious Education. We also celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation for 30 young adults from the parish and school. Thanks to the teachers from the school and Religious Education for preparing the children to receive the sacraments.

There were many celebrations at St. James School that were also memorable. I thank the principal and the staff for all that they do for the better future of St. James School and the hundreds of volunteers that keep St. James School on the high level of excellence.

The Memorial Day mass in the cemetery was well attended and was an opportunity for us to pray for our beloved. We celebrated the 3rd death anniversaries of Fr. John O'Neill, M.S and Sr. Anila SABS and in 2025 we saw many of our wonderful parishioners and friends go home to God. Let us continue to remember all those special people in our prayers. May they all rest in peace!

We were able to complete the re-pointing of the church and sealed it during the year. Many other renovations and improvements continued within the Church, School, Rectory, and Convent throughout the year. I know it was possible only with your support. And we continue to need your support to finish the new painting and renovation project inside the church which begins this week.

I take this opportunity to thank two special people who retired from their ministries this year. Deacon Rene Barbeau, who was a great supporter of our parish and school for 24 years, retired from the active ministry due to health reasons. Let us continue to pray for his good health.
