## DAYDREAMS OF A PASTOR...



The observance of Ash Wednesday insists that we should experience a complete conversion of heart and not simply regret our sins. Saint Paul in his second letter to the Corinthians advises us “to become reconciled to God.” There is a need to express our repentance by becoming reconciled with God daily, by asking for forgiveness.

“Return to me”, Jesus says. “But where are you, Lord, so that we can return” We ask. “Look into your heart and health,” he says... He waits within, in the entrails, while we seek him overseas.

Lent is not just about little sacrifices we make, but about discerning where our hearts are directed. This is the core of Lent: asking where our hearts are directed... The ashes on our head this week will remind us that ‘we are dust and unto dust we will return...’ We will always be dust, but as a liturgical hymn says, ‘dust in love.’ Let us pray once more to the Holy Spirit and rediscover the fire of praise, which consumes the ashes of lamentation and resignation.

Every Lent, we think about things we should give up. We think about the temptations we should resist, the devils we should conquer, and the evils we should overcome. As Jesus was confronted and challenged in the desert by the devil, we too are particularly challenged or diminished. So, the question we should ask ourselves about this lent is not what we can give up. Instead, it is what we can do more for God?

As we begin our Lenten pilgrimage, let's remember that our almsgiving, prayer and fasting are precious to our loving Father in heaven. He delights in those moments of close friendship and does not want them spoiled. So, let's do them quietly, without making any fanfare, for him, and for him alone: for our Father in heaven *who sees in secret*.

*Loving Father, bless this holy time of Lent. Through it may we come to know you more intimately and to serve our brothers and sisters more generously. Amen.*

## SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## First Reading: Sirach 15:15-20

This passage from Sirach gives strong, unequivocal emphasis to free will in every person. Before each of us is set, sin or virtue, life or death, and each of us are free to choose the one or the other.

## Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:6-10

Paul explains to the Corinthians that there are two different kinds of wisdom — the wisdom of God and the wisdom of the world. The wisdom of God is mysterious, but this wisdom has been revealed “to those who love him” through the Spirit.

## Gospel: Matthew 5:17-37

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus tells the people he has come to fulfill the law. He speaks strongly against murder and anger, against adultery and lust, and against false oaths and lies. He warns the people that unless their virtue exceeds that of the Pharisees, they “will not enter the kingdom of God.”






